

AgriNorthwest is seeking a results-driven **Irrigation Pivot Technician** to safely operate and maintain the center pivots and valves in assigned area. This technician is expected to perform high quality work to ensure low downtime and provide for the needs of the farm with limited supervision. This job is based in Plymouth, WA.

Responsibilities:

- Perform system alignment and obtain an understanding of the stresses in the Warren and Bowstring trussing systems and the effects of loading.
- Test circuits in both clusters and pivots as well as locate and replace defective parts. Troubleshoots electrical problems and makes timely repairs and new installations as needed.
- Make timely adjustments repairs and maintenance to pressure regulating valves.
- Make motor replacements and repairs on gearboxes, drive lines, and tires. Maintain components so that center pivots are run in a manner which will prevent and avoid damage.
- Skillfully weld pipe and repair irrigation equipment using welders, acetylene torches and other tools as necessary.
- Reads and apply system and electrical schematics and wiring diagrams.
- Identify system structural components and assemblies, disassemble, and relocate center pivot machines. React quickly to repair machines that have fallen down to meet the irrigation needs of a crop.
- Maintain necessary maintenance records and tools to function properly as required.
- Ensure adherence to company procedures, policies and safety rules. Keep current with all safety devices and emergency shutdown procedures and ensures that they are functioning at all times.
- Respond to system emergencies 24/7 during irrigation season.
- Become familiar with MSDS sheets, pesticide labels and application notification procedures and champion the use of appropriate personal protective equipment.

Requirements:

- 2-4 years of progressive experience with center pivot maintenance.
- Possesses a valid, in-state driver's license.
- First-Aid and CPR certifications.
- Understanding of Electrical Code, Safety, and LOTO and Arc Flash.
- Demonstrated display of high integrity and honesty.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Meet the physical requirements of the role which includes occasional lifting up to 70 pounds, bending, kneeling, and twisting throughout work period. Occasional long-term standing, sitting, and walking during work. Able to work and climb to heights of greater than 10' using proper equipment and fall protection.
- Willing and able to work 12 hours days in all weather conditions, up to six days a week.
- Available to respond to emergencies that may arise with irrigation system.
- Self-motivated and able to manage time to meet critical deadlines.
